38/11 Minutes of the last meeting . Approved by the Council and Signed as a true and correct record of the last meeting

Highways footpath drain outside The Plough. Still awaiting reply from ERYC. Cllr Thackery to forward to the Clerk photos of the problem.

Gas Pipe. Transco now changed to National Grid Ltd, Could not find records of first visit by engineer, but sent engineer out on 23/02/12 Clerk to follow up this visit. Cllr Thackery stated that when the beck floods the pipe is covered and this will only lead to the pipe deteriorating further.

Litter bin/dog waste bag stand. Cllrs decided not to place either a bin, or a stand which provides Dog Waste Bags. Has been explained in the Hayton/Burnby newsletter that waste may be placed in any of the village litter bins and even household bins.

Beck Clearance and Ownership: Clerk to chase up after the Drainage board has gone through its change. Cllrs explained that from the A1079 toward Bielby the beck is the responsibility of the Enviroment Agency , From the A1079 towards Burnby the beck is the responsibility of the riparian owners. Under the actual bridge is the responsibility of the ERYC Highways Dept.
