Elections for East Riding of Yorkshire Council and Hayton and Burnby Parish Council will take place on Thursday 4th May.

#### **Voter Identification**

For the first time anyone wishing to vote at a polling station will need to produce a form of photo identification e.g. passport, driving licence or bus pass. Voters without photo ID can apply online for a free voter authority certificate or make an appointment at a library or customer service centre for assistance.

Alternatively people may register for a postal vote.
